Our Itinerary

Day 1: Overnight stay in Belgium

Meals: None

Day 2: We travel to Berlin for a 2 night stay. En route, we stop by the Mohne Dam, which is one of the dams that was attacked during World War II by the Dambusters.

Meals: Breakfast and Dinner.

Day 3 Berlin: Explore this historic city with a guide on our Berlin sightseeing tour (optional) that includes the Berlin Cathedral, Brandenburg Gate and the infamous Berlin Wall. With many large department stores and trendy fashion boutiques, Berlin is a shopper's haven.

Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

Day 4: Travel to Warsaw where we stay for two nights.
Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

Day 5 Warsaw: The Polish capital was virtually destroyed during World War II but was rebuilt in just 13 years. Our guided sightseeing tour (optional, included on Silver Service) takes in the castles, monuments and cathedrals at the heart of this robust city.
Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

Day 6 Jasna Gora and Auschwitz: A fascinating trip to the 4th century Paulite Monastery at Jasna Gora and it's famous 'Black Madonna'. Afterwards, we travel to Auschwitz Concentration Camp for a remembrance visit. Continue to Krakow for a 2 night stay.
Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

Day 7 Krakow with Guided Sightseeing Tour: Krakow's Old Town is on the UNESCO list of protected World Historic Sites on account of it's fabulous architecture. In the afternoon, join our optional visit to the Wieliczka Salt Mines where salt mining has continued since the Middle Ages.

Day 8: Travel to Budapest where we stay for two nights.
Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

Day 9 Budapest: Our guided Budapest sightseeing tour (optional, included on Silver Service) features some of the city's most popular sights including the impressive Parliament Buildings, St Stephen's Cathedral, Heros Square and the huge Citadel. You also have the option to take a relaxing lunch cruise along the majestic 'Blue' Danube to enjoy the great scenery.

Day 10: We travel to Vienna arriving early afternoon. Our optional guided sightseeing tour is the perfect way to see the sights. We'll see the State Opera House, Parliament and the Ringstrasse. In the evening, there is the option of a Mozart concert with the Vienna Residence Orchestra. The overnight stay is in the Vienna Woods area.
